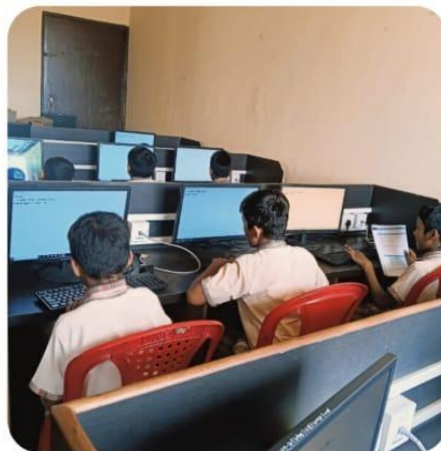
Visit to Science Centre

Scout Guide

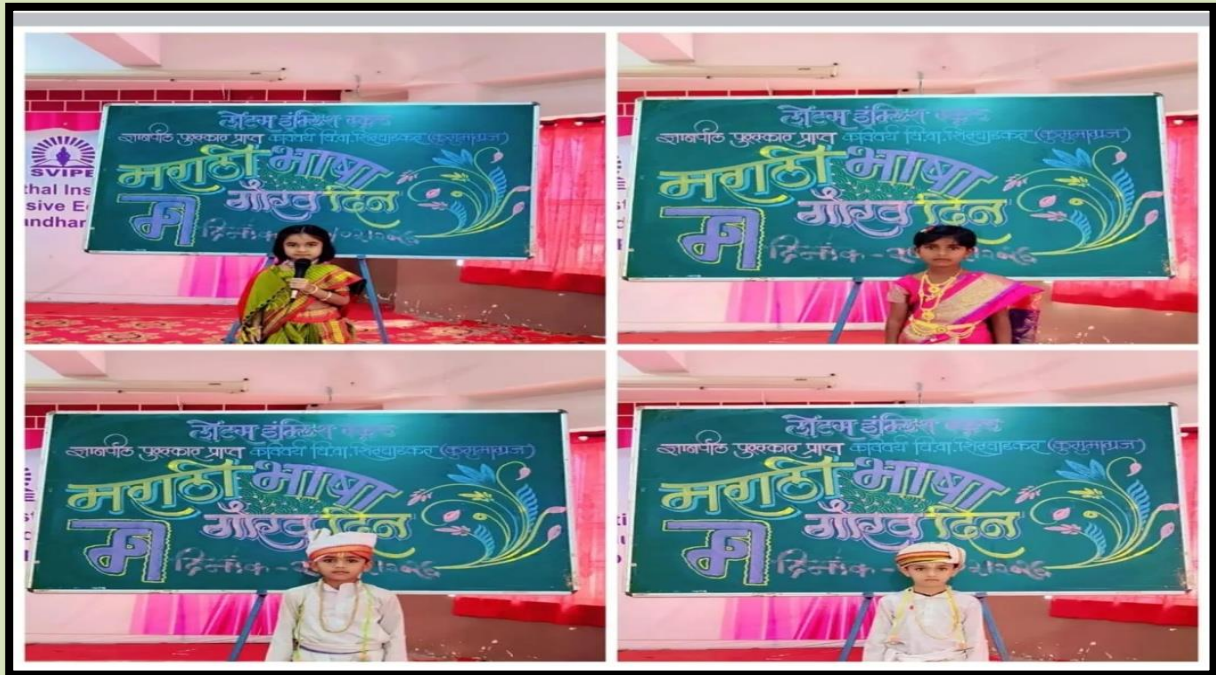

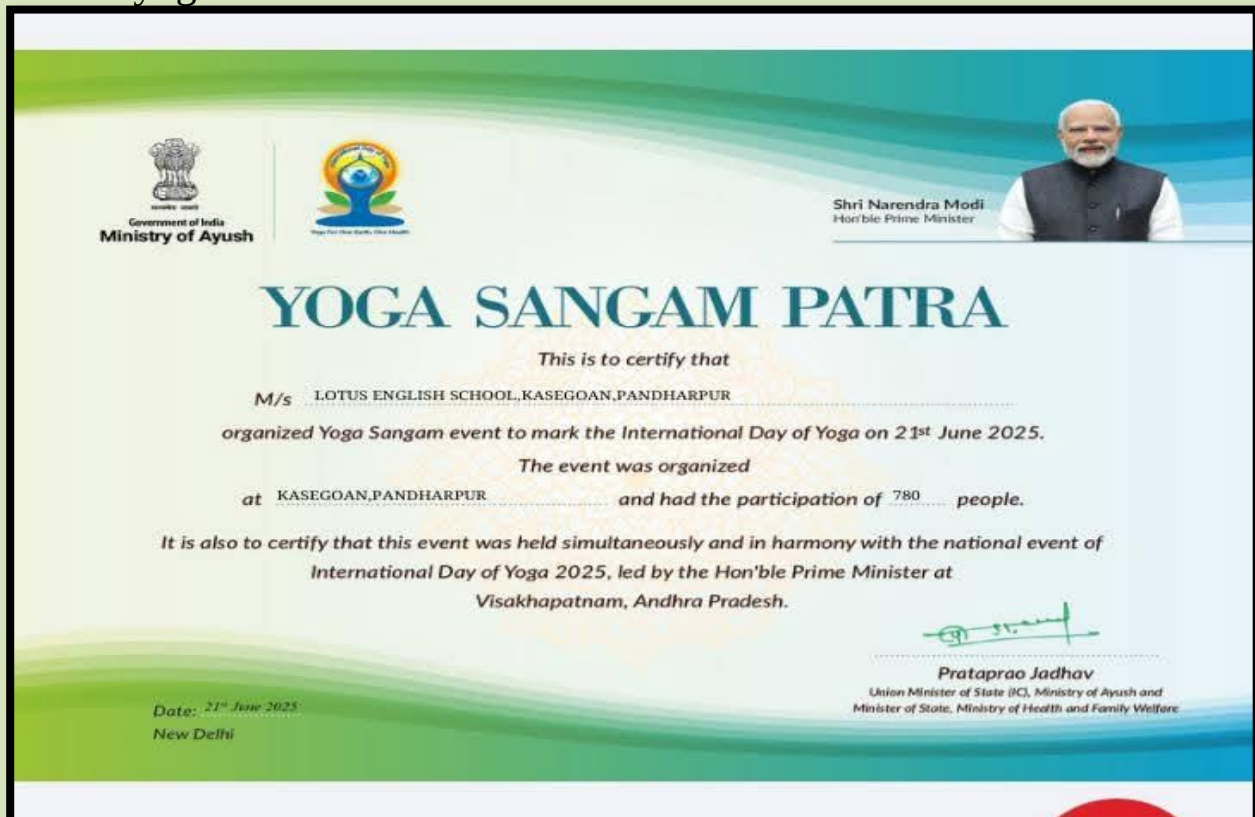


INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY

The event aimed to promote a healthy lifestyle and highlight the benefits of yoga for overall wellness.

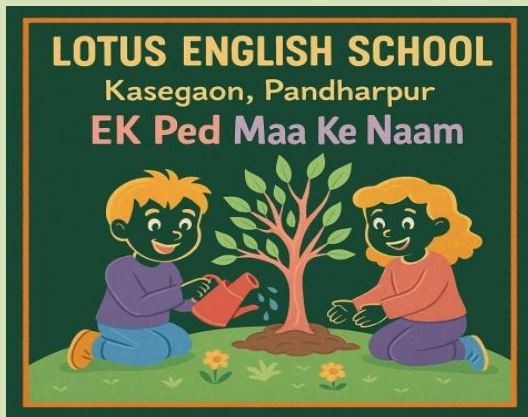

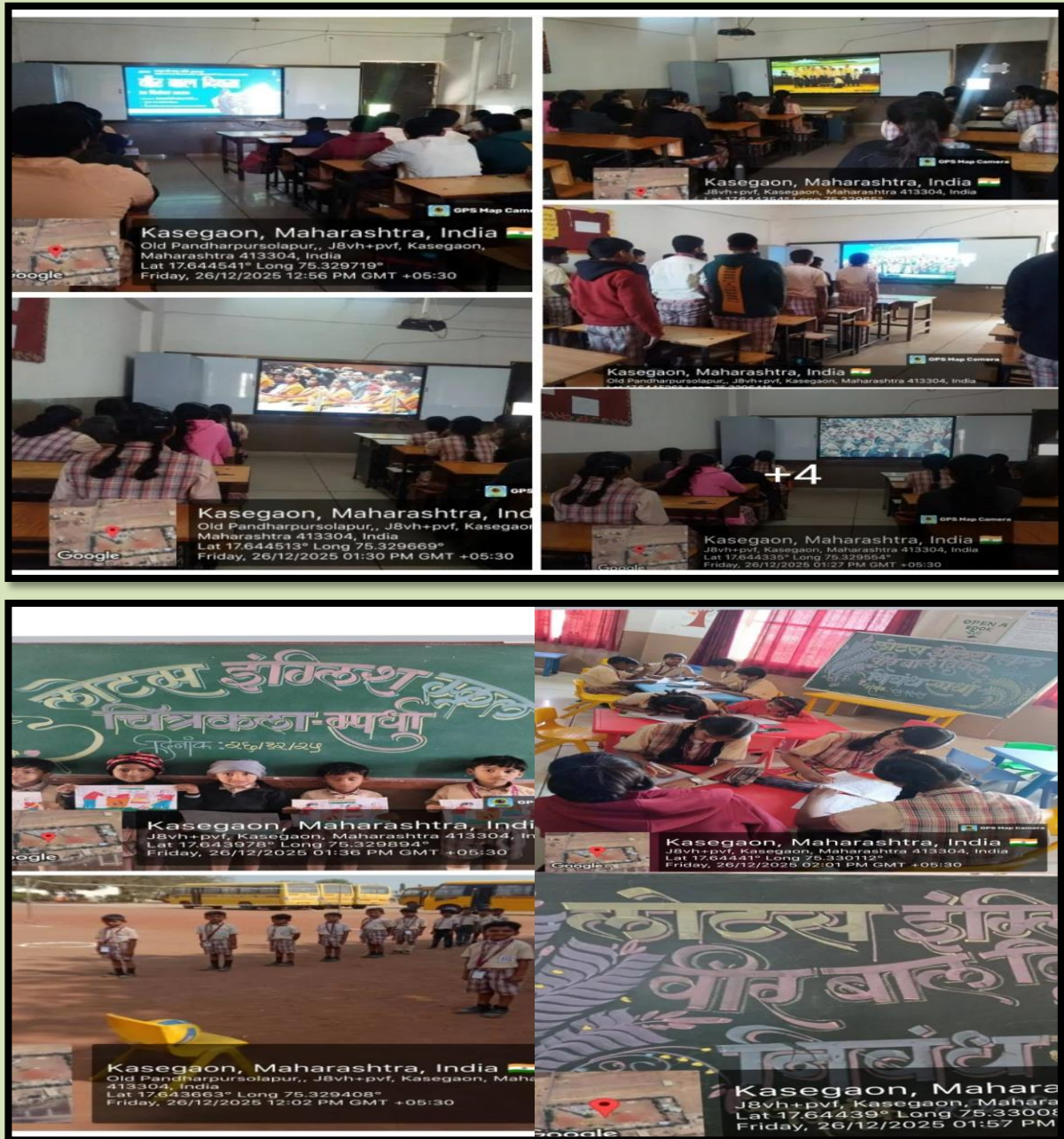

SCIENCE INSPIRATION SESSION

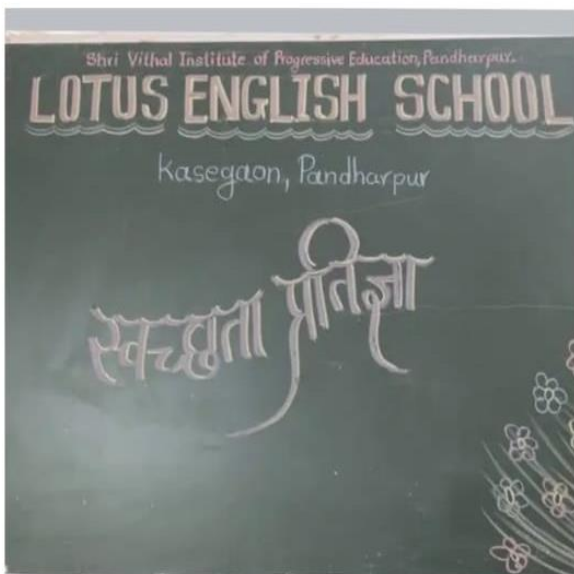
Senior Scientist Prof. Venkatesh Gambhir Visits Lotus English School

Swachhata Pakhwada

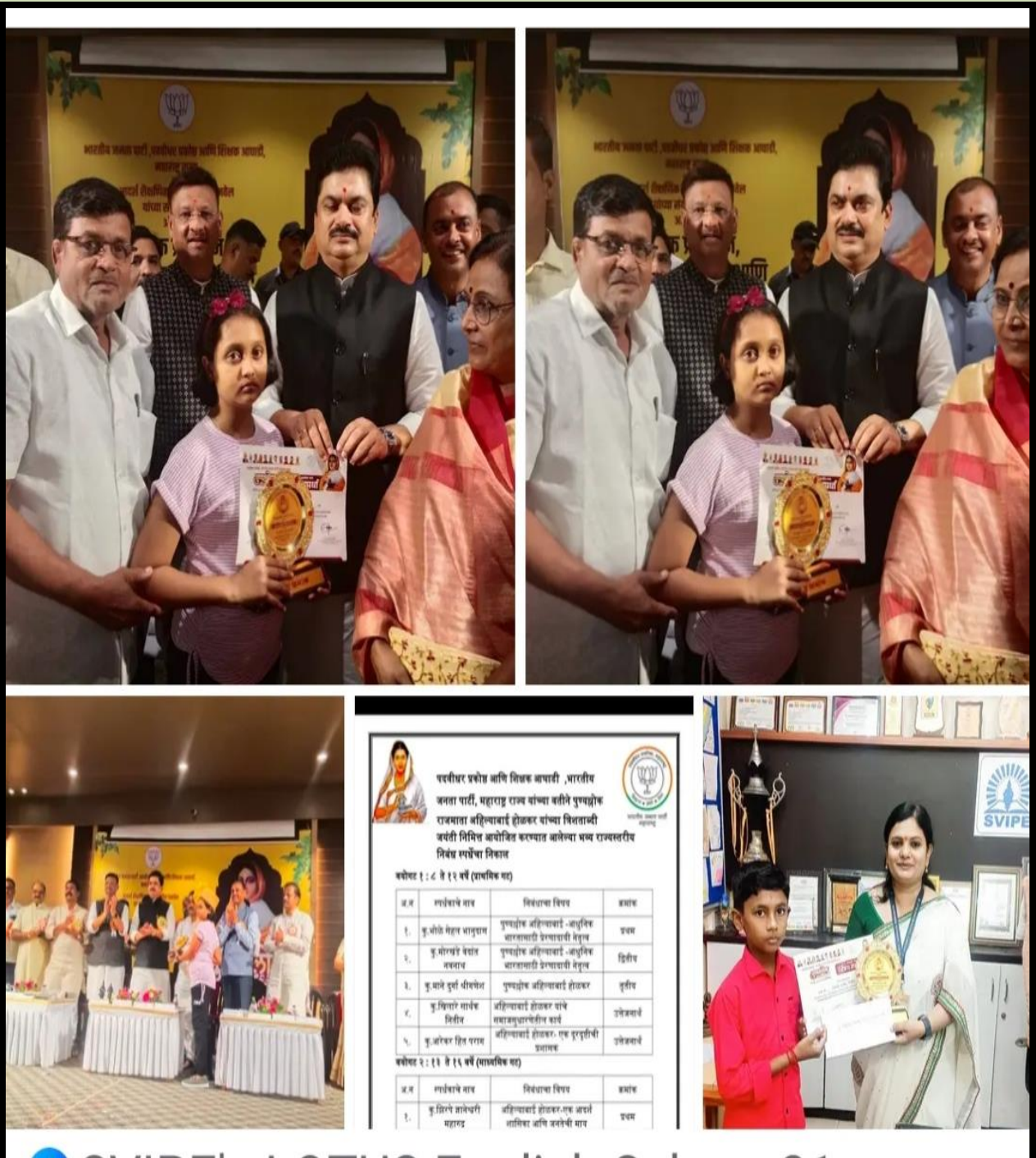

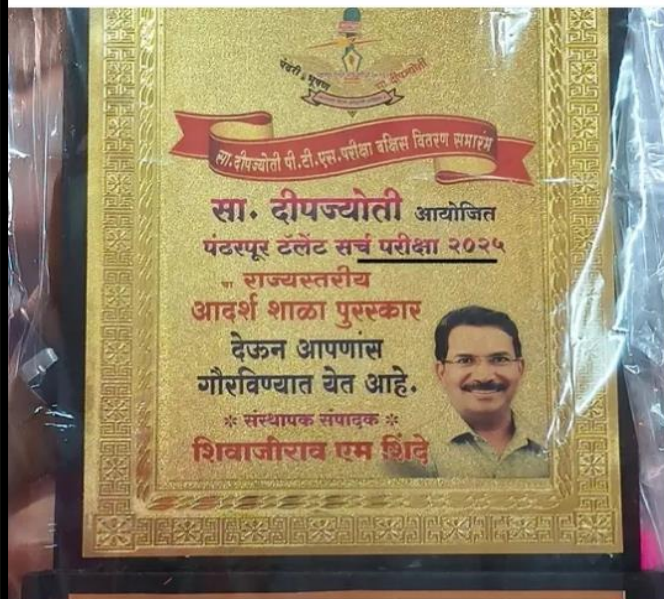
